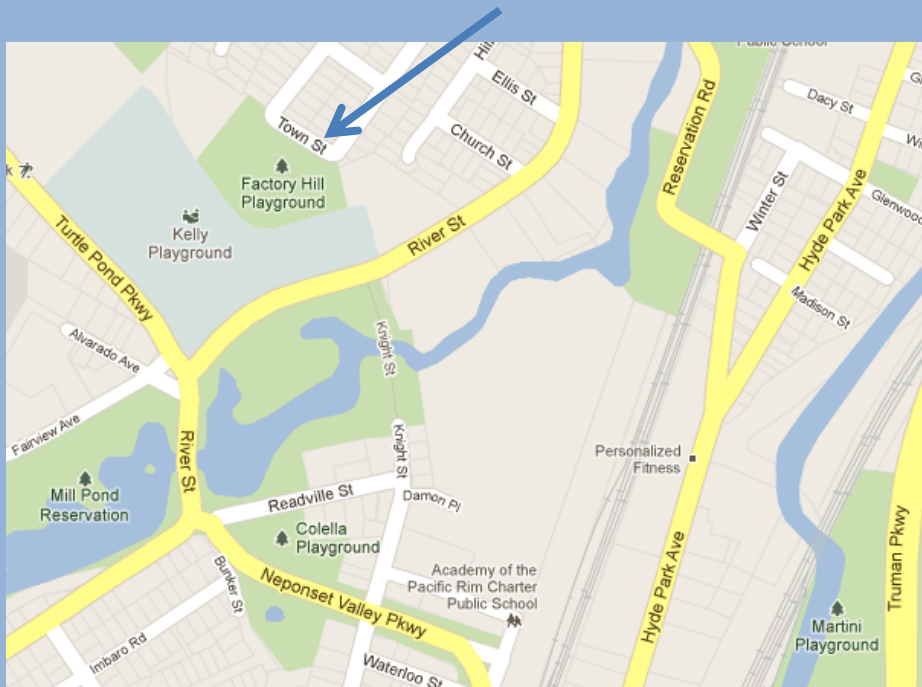




RainforestMaker thanks you for helping to make our May 19, 2012 Lawyers Accountable To The Earth (LATTE) tree planting a success!
